PSAT - Attention juniors and sophomores: The PSAT will be given at Norwin on Saturday, October 16th. In homeroom this morning, juniors received a registration form for the PSAT. Juniors will begin registering for the PSAT on Monday, September 13th. Sophomores will receive their registration forms in homeroom next week.
