Dear Class of 2009:

The Pennon staff invites students to submit their senior portraits for the yearbook. This year students may have their portraits taken at any studio of their choice. However, the following guidelines must be followed in order for your portrait to appear in the 2008-2009 Pennon.

- The portrait must be of the head and shoulders only. Please no looking over your shoulder, lying down, hands in the picture, or extremely close up pictures of your face.
- Seniors must wear school appropriate clothing for the picture. Boys are encouraged to wear ties and girls may not wear tube tops or tank tops of any kind. Remember: if you cannot wear it to school, you should not wear it for your senior portrait.
- The background for your portrait should be a pastel or light color. Please do not choose dark blues or reds or blacks.
- The deadline for photo submissions is December 31, 2008.
- It is your responsibility to see that the Pennon staff receives the portrait. If you go to a studio such as Impressions, tell the photographer that you are from Norwin and he will see that we get the picture. When we do receive the photo, we will send a postcard to your home.
- The picture may be given to the yearbook advisor on a CD or as a hard copy photo. It may also be e-mailed to the yearbook advisor at RThompson@norwinsd.org.
- The yearbook staff cannot perform any touch-ups on the photos. Thus, the photo we get is the photo that will appear in the yearbook.
- If you would prefer to have your picture taken at school, a photographer from Buchman's will be scheduled sometime in January. There will be no sitting fee for this photo. You will have the opportunity to purchase the pictures.
- The photo we receive is considered property of the yearbook staff and will not be returned.
- The Pennon staff reserves the right to reject any portrait not considered appropriate.
