CONTENT TUTORING - ENGLISH, MATH, SCIENCE AND SOCIAL STUDIES

To participate in after school tutoring students must sign-up the **MORNING** of the day they are planning on staying. Sign-ups are in the Guidance Office. Students need to list what subject and service they need and come to the Library with the appropriate class materials. Students must also arrange a pick-up to get home (transportation is not provided for after school tutoring).

Morning tutoring can also be available from 7:05 - 7:35AM Monday through Thursday in the Middle School Library. We ask that students who wish to attend morning tutoring inform their School Counselor or Mrs. Fairgrieve, the Guidance Secretary, the **DAY BEFORE** they are planning to attend.

National Junior Honor Society PEER TUTORING -
